## S.C. Career Opportunity and Access for All Act What's in it for school boards?

Education reform legislation filed in the House and Senate recently is making headlines. The 80-plus page bill, the **South Carolina Opportunity and Access for All Act**, is being touted as the largest legislative effort to overhaul education in 35 years. Most of the talk has centered on changes for teacher pay and the creation of another state-level education committee. But what changes may be in store for local school boards? Spend lunchtime with SCSBA legislative staff to review highlights of this legislation, specifically, the impact for school board members, including increased reporting requirements, new ethics rules, mandatory training and nepotism policies, school district takeovers, forced consolidations and more.
