Thursday – Keynote speaker John-Michael Keyes will share the remarkable story of the



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I Love U Guys Foundation, created after a 2006 school shooting that left his daughter Emily dead. Hear about the foundation's efforts – including development of the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) – to help make schools more secure for children. The morning will continue with a look at risk management for special events. If you have concerns about liability related to concerts, games and other events, you will find this session to be especially engaging and valuable. A late-morning discussion will focus on functional capacity evaluations and the importance of effective return-to-work programs for injured workers. After lunch, learn about risk management strategies from a panel of school administrators.

Friday – Learn about ways your employees can maintain a healthy lifestyle. From minimizing absences from work to reducing the incidence of workplace injury, employee well-being is an important part of your district's success. The seminar will wrap up with an overview of effective practices by Daniel J. Pliszka, manager of the Risk Management Division Manager with the City of Charlotte.
