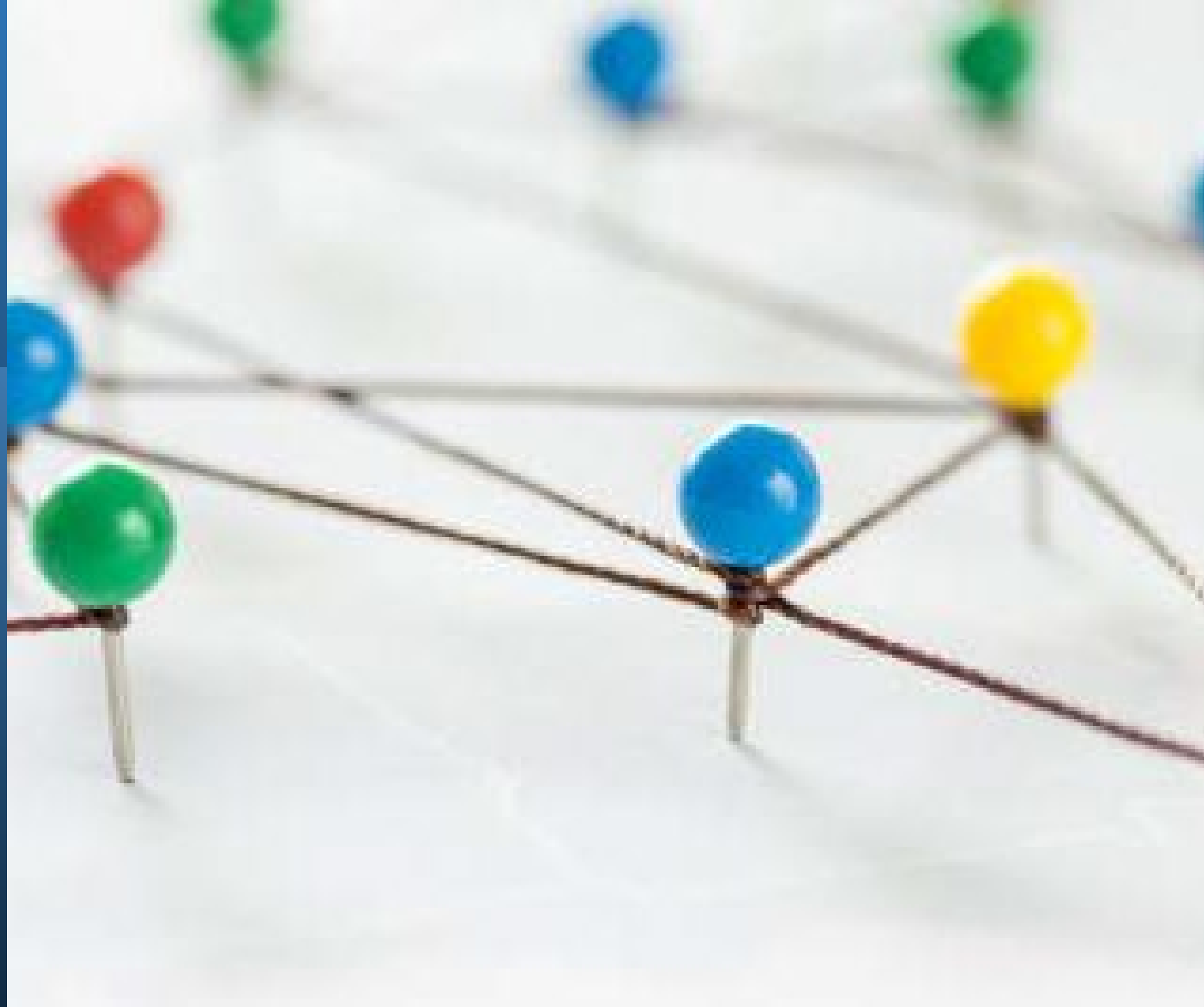


Overview

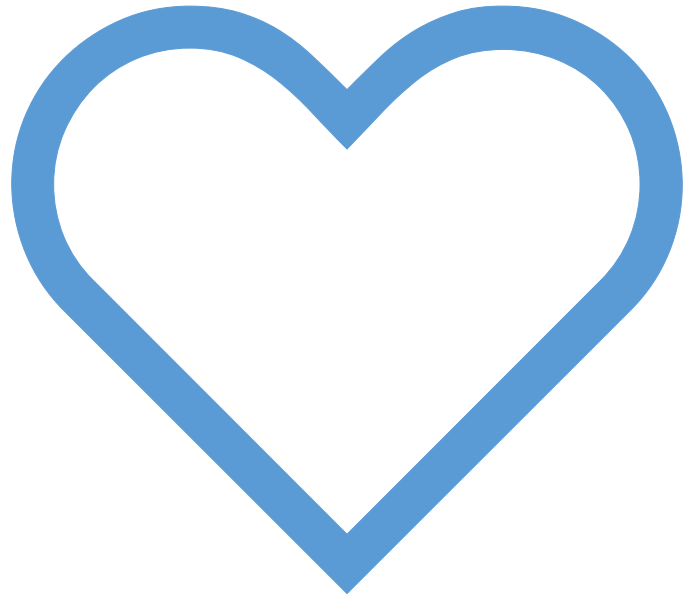


Connections to Your Heart to Do Good

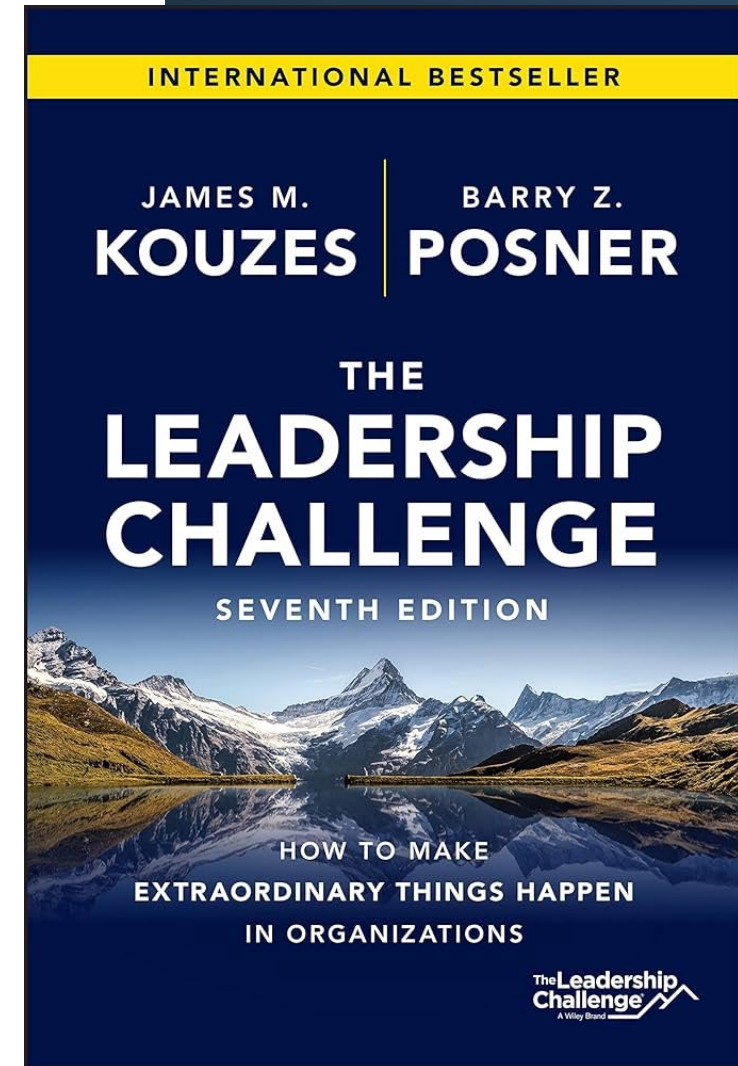
