SUBJECT: 2026 SCSBA Annual Convention - Student Entertainment RFP

The 2026 SCSBA Annual Convention planning is underway and we are now in search of school district student entertainment groups to **perform** at this flagship event. This year our Convention is scheduled for February 19-22, 2026, at the Kingston Resorts in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Please review the following requirements and considerations prior to submitting your application:

- > The district pays all expenses for the group to travel to Myrtle Beach, including food, lodging and transportation.
- > If you have performed at an SCSBA conference, you must wait two years to perform again.
- > SCSBA provides normal staging requirements: microphones and risers.
- > A raised stage may be provided but no full-size stage is available.
- > All groups must arrive 30 minutes before performance time. A holding room will be available.
- > Performances are limited to 10 minutes.
- > Approximate student group performance times: 8:30 a.m. Friday, 8:30 a.m. Saturday and 8:30 a.m. Sunday. Please keep all dates open for scheduling purposes. The performance date and time will be selected by SCSBA.

Once you begin the online process, you must complete the application. You will not be able to save and return to your application later.
